Prif nod Cyngor Cymuned Llangunnor yw gwasanaethu'r Gymuned. Dros y blynyddoedd diwethaf mae wedi buddsoddi bron i £50K mewn gwelliannau yn y parc lleol; mae wedi gwelliannu / ymestyn llwybrau o amgylch y gymuned ac wedi gosod seddi; mae'n cefnogi sefydliadau lleol gyda grantiau ac mae'n rhoi rhoddion i elusennau lleol yn flynyddol: mae'r digwyddiad Nadolig wedi tyfu dros y blynyddoedd ac mae bellach yn un o'r uchafbwyntiau i blant ysgol lleol. Yn ystod y flwyddyn gyfredol a'i heriau, mae wedi rhoi £ 1000 i Banc Bwyd Caerfyrddin, ac wedi darparu grant o £50 i deuluoedd yr effeithiwyd arnynt gan dynnu cludiant ysgol yn ôl i QE High. Mae ganddi berthynas waith ragorol gyda'r ysgol gynradd leol, Cyngor Tref Caerfyrddin a Chyngor Sir Gaerfyrddin.

Llangunnor Community Council main aim is to serve the Community. Over the past few years, it has invested nearly £50K in improvements at the local park; it has carried improvements / extended paths around the community and placed seating; it supports local organisations with grants and it annually makes donations to local charities: the Christmas event has grown over the years and is now one of the highlights for local school children. During the current year and its challenges, it has given £1000 to the Carmarthen Foodbank, and provided a £50 grant for families affected by the with-drawl of school transport to QE High. It has an excellent working relationship with the local primary school, Carmarthen Town Council and Carmarthenshire County Council.
