Appendix 1

Main Entrance

- * Place bollards on the pavement outside the park to limit cars parking on the pavement (x2)
- * Replace the tactile paving outside the park - was taken up when Welsh Water were working on the road
- * Consider installing a pedestrian gate when the new fence is installed, this would hopefully make it less likely that stray dogs could wonder into the park

- * Repair “No parking” sign and consider moving it onto the vehicle access gate
- * Consider replacing/treating rusty chain on vehicle access gate
- * Consider location of bin when new fence in position, could we re-purpose the post no parking sign currently attached to?
- * Paint wooden fence – ensure this is added on to maintenance plan (to be developed)
- * New bilingual signage at park, to comply with H&S and to promote Llangunnor Community Council

Enclosed Play Area

- * Sun/Rain canopy over new play area, with potential to extend
 - * Ensure that gate in new play area works correctly and complies with H&S
 - * The strip of land at the left-hand side of the entire children's area needs to be tarmacked
- Remove and replace fencing around the old play area to match the fencing at the new area to create one large play area
- Replace grass with new artificial grass in old play area
- Replace rocker and repair stepping stones and balance beam
- Replace missing items from equipment
- Cut back hedge running alongside path (Mr Bowen) and reinstate more secure fencing
- Could more seating be placed close to the children's play area

Climbing Frame/Swing Area

- Safety surface under climbing frame, this to help ensure council complies with H&S
- Safety surface under swings, this to help ensure council complies with H&S (erosion)
- Consider anti wrap fixtures for swings
- Consider the need for a new piece of equipment for older children in space between swings

General

- Plant daffodils around the park (56 pound sack)
- Consider secure storage box
- Power supply to the park
- Water supply to the park (drinking fountain)
- Edging on all paths to be concrete curb stones, when paths are repaired the wooden edging be replaced
- Teen shelter

A vandal proof canopy/ shelter
Re-instate hedges between park and Maes Lewis Morris close off access points into the park
Wildflower areas
Bird/bat boxes – eco friendly council
Hedgehog hotels/ bee friendly plants etc
Consider creating a BBQ area
Plant fruit trees and fruit bushes in park, giving something back to the community
Find permanent and secure location for small picnic table
Cap benches
More permanent toilet solution for park
Fencing around boundary of park

Skate Park/Basket Ball Area

- * Paint and repair basketball hoop
- * Redevelop skate park area/possibly expand. (H&S concerns)
- * Clear out area behind skate park
- * Not sure how much use is made of the skateboard ramps. Is there any way they could be moved to another part of the park
- * Could skate park area (tarmacked) have playground games such as Hopscotch, Snakes and Ladders, Mazes etc painted onto it
- * Any possibility of extending that area past the basketball post to put some other outdoor activity there e.g. table tennis

Lewis Morris Entrance

- * Gated entrance to the park from Maes Lewis Morris
- * Small noticeboard at Maes Lewis Morris entrance
- * Clear/landscape area by bridge, develop the natural waterway – encourage biodiversity

BMX Area

- * Redevelop BMX area, make it more user friendly and look at possible drainage solutions
- * Clear brambles behind BMX area back to hedge line
- * Reclaim the hedges at the back of the BMX track and plant trees
- * For a bigger project update the BMX area. It had a lot of use during lockdown. It looks so outdated now and is in need of improvement.

Football Area

- * Level football area, look to drain and fence off to create a good quality playing area

Woodland Area/ Upper Park Area / Top Picnic Area

- * Woodland area – consideration of opening it up to the public, possibly removing fence or repairing
- * Wooden wall – maintenance plan needed
- * Infill crack in concrete base (old hut)
- * Sort out lip on ramp from gym equipment to concrete base
- * Fence off a part of the park for dogs off leads with a large gate for the tractor to cut the grass and a small gate for the public access
