- 2. The minutes of the meeting held on 6th June 2018 were confirmed as a true record (Minute 0818 W/M2).

3. Newsletter.

Cllr. Slate circulated a draft of the newsletter, she explained that this was a more comprehensive edition in order that residents could be informed of who sits on the Council, what the council's roles are, how decisions are reached and how it is all financed, it would also include a news section. Clerk to make enquiries about cost of translation.

Slate by Friday 10th if possible, she would then circulate an amended edition for members of the sub-committee with a view to getting it all agreed by the week ending 24th. Clerk to check whether a prize can be given in a free prize draw for residents who respond.

4. Web Page.

- c) Community Section little change at the moment
- d) Clerk to work on Terms of Reference for each sub-committee.
