Cynhelir cyfarfod 'o bell' o'r Pwyllgor Parc ac Amgylcheddol ar 3 Mai 2023 am 6.30y.h.

I drafod yr agenda a ganlyn:

iv) Cais a wnaed i Gyngor Sir Caerfyrddin o dan eu Cynllun Grant Cymunedau Cynaliadwy am grant o £10000 i dalu 50% o gost TCC o £3500, a

atgyweiriadau i arwyneb chwarae rhan uchaf y plant bach eto ar 50% o'r gost yn

£6500. Bydd arian cyfatebol yn dod o'n 106 balans a'r gweddill

£6500 o'r cronfeydd wrth gefn.

Roedd y ffenestr ymgeisio yn fyr iawn ac nid yw'n ein hymrwymo mewn unrhyw fodd.

Fodd bynnag, ar yr ochr arall os bydd yn llwyddiannus bydd yn ein helpu i ariannu cyfran fawr o'r gwariant uchod yn rhannol.

Cyflwynwyd y cais yn dilyn trafodaethau llafar gyda Chadeirydd ac Is-Gadeirydd y Cyngor, a'r Cynghorydd Sir Elwyn Williams. Disgwyl penderfyniad yn eiddgar.

v) Tynnu coed peryglus yn y fynedfa a gosod clawdd.

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5. Ystyried adroddiad Archwiliad Gweithredol Cae Chwarae Llangynnwr ar gyfer Mawrth 23 sydd eisoes wedi'i ddosbarthu'n electronig i'r holl Gynghorwyr.
6. Cynnig gan y Cyng Jenny Slate –" Ystyried darparu goleuadau yn y parc.
Mae'r parc yn dywyll iawn yn ystod misoedd y gaeaf a byddai pobl yn mynd â chŵn am Dro yn elwa o rai goleuo. Gall hefyd leddfu ymddygiad gwrthgymdeithasol a fandaliaeth".
7. O ystyried y bydd cysylltiad trydan ar gael yn fuan yn y Parc, a
gan gadw mewn cof y llifeiriant diweddar o ymddygiad gwrthgymdeithasol a fandaliaeth a welwyd o fewn mynedfa'r parc ystyriaeth i'w rhoi i ddarparu TCC. A
derbyniwyd dyfynbris o £6200 ynghyd â TAW gan Dyfed Alarms, sydd wedi bod,
yn cael ei ddosbarthu'n electronig i'r holl Gynghorwyr y mae Gweithredu Gwyliadwriaeth Wedi'u dewisi beidio ag ailadrodd y tro hwn. Mae C C Sir Gaerfyrddin wedi cadarnhau y gall 106 o arianlle byddai'n llwyddo i dalu 50% o'r gost yma yn ogystal â chynllunio a ffioedd proffesiynol lle amcangyfrifir bod cyfanswm cost y prosiect i fod yn y rhanbarth o £7000 ynghyd â TAW. Bydd cais hefyd yn cael ei gyflwyno i'r Heddlu a Throseddu Swyddfa'r Comisiynydd am gyllid unwaith y ceir canlyniad grant y Cyngor
Mae'r cais yn hysbys, gan iddo gytuno i ailystyried cais am arian
Tuag at y gost o osod TCC.
8. Diweddariad gan y Cadeirydd ar arwyddion y Parc.
9. Angen gwaith pellach i dorri canghennau bargodol ar y tair coeden dderw wedi'i leoli ger y bwrdd sgrialu a'r cylch pêl-rwyd, sydd wedi'i nodi gan y Arolygydd parc fel un sy'n peri risg iechyd a diogelwch posibl i ddefnyddwyr.

Wedi ymgolli yn y canghenau Mae Gorchmynion Cadw Coed wedi'u gosod ar bob un o'r

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tair coeden dan sylw a bydd angen gwneud cais i'r Swyddog Coed yn Sir Gaerfyrddin am trwydded i wneud y gwaith hwn. Ystyried cael peiriant i mewn i lefelu'r ardal ar waelod y parc wedi'i adfer yn ddiweddar ar ôl clirio prysgwydd i dacluso i fyny'r maes hwn sydd wedi'i esgeuluso'n fawr, a fydd yn caniatáu rheolaeth fwy cost-effeithiol haws yn ymlaen yn ol ailhadu, gan y gallai y tractor a peiriant torri gwair wrth dorri gwair y parc.

10. Adleoli toiledau a fandaliaeth a dargedwyd yn ddiweddar.

11. Dyddiad y cyfarfod nesaf i'w hysbysu gan y Clerc

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A 'remote' meeting of the Park & Environmental Committee will be held on 3rd May 2023 at 6.30p.m.

To transact the following agenda:

- 1 To receive apologies for absence.
- 2 To receive any declarations of Interest.
- 3 Minutes of previous meeting held on 25th January 2023 previously circulated.
- 4 Clerk to provide update on the following:
 - i) Park maintenance and repair contract-Dragon Playgrounds
 - ii) Update from National Grid on the electricity connection for the park.
 - iii) New seating within toddlers play area.
 - iv) Application made to Carms CC under their Sustainable Communities Grant Scheme for a grant of £10000 to cover 50% of the cost of CCTV at £3500, and repairs to the playing surface of the upper toddler area again at 50% of cost at £6500. Match funding would come from our 106 balances and the remaining £6500 from reserves. The Clerk had identified this grant as a potential source of funding from his research.

The application window was very short and does not commit us in anyway. However, on the upside if successful will help us part fund a large proportion of the above expenditure, with minimal recourse to our cash reserves.

The application was submitted following verbal discussions with the Chair and Vice Chair of the Council, and County Councillor Elwyn Williams. Decision eagerly awaited.
 - v) Removal of dangerous trees at the entrance and laying of hedge.
5. To consider Llangunnor Playground Operational Inspection report for March 23 which has already been circulated electronically to all Councillors.
6. Motion from Cllr Jenny Slate –" To consider the provision of lighting in the park. The park is very dark in the winter months and people dog walking would benefit

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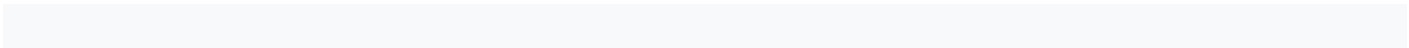
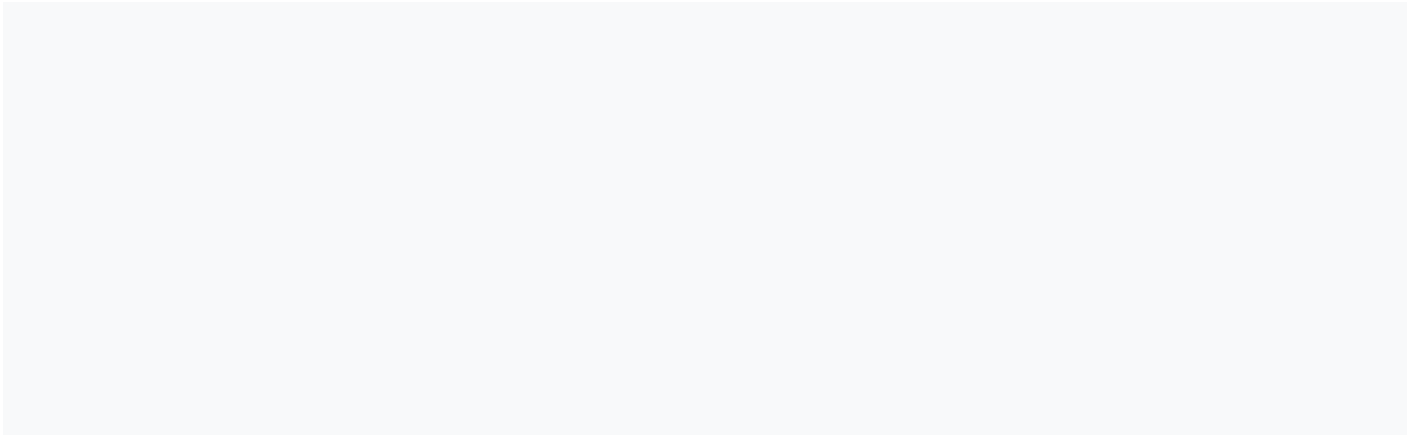
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from some lighting. It may also alleviate anti-social behaviour and vandalism”.

7. Given that an electricity connection will become available shortly at the Park, and being mindful of the recent spate of anti-social behaviour and vandalism seen within the park entrance consideration to be given to the provision of CCTV. A quote of £6200 plus Vat having been received from Dyfed Alarms which has, been, circulated electronically to all Councillors where Action Surveillance has chosen. not to requote on this occasion. Carms C C have confirmed that 106 monies can be used for this project which would cover 50% of the cost in addition to planning and professional fees where it is estimated that total project cost to be in the region of £7000 plus Vat. An application will also be submitted to The Police and Crime Commissioner’s Office for funding once the outcome of the Council grant Application is known, as he has agreed to reconsider an application for funding towards the cost of installing CCTV.
8. Update from the Chair on Park signage.
9. Further work required to cut back overhanging branches on the three Oak trees situated near the skateboard and net ball hoop, which has been identified by the Park inspector as posing a potential health and safety risk to users, becoming entangled in the branches.
All three trees in question have Tree Preservation Orders placed upon them, and will require an application to be made to the Tree Officer At Carms C C for a licence to undertake this work. Consideration to getting a machine in to level the area at the bottom of the park recently recovered following scrub clearance to tidy up this much neglected area, which will allow for easier cost-effective management going forward following reseeding, as it could then be mown by the tractor and mower whilst undertaking the grass cut of the park.
