Minutes of the Meeting of Llangunnor Community Council held in Babell Zion Chapel on Tuesday 20th January 2026 after the main meeting which began at 19:00 – this meeting opened 19:51

The meeting was convened to discuss the following agenda:

- 261) To receive apologies for absence - were received from Cllr Matthew Williams
- 262) To record all declarations of interest – Cllr E. Williams - Cllr holds seat on Planning with County Council so refrains from voting (267)
- 263) To approve the minutes of the planning meeting of Council held on 16th December 2025 **APPROVED** (1 abs)
- 264) Update on Meeting of Community Councils to discuss Teifi / Tywi & Tywi / Usk pylon line project – Meeting held on 1st December 2025 – minutes in appendix. Most recent meeting 13th January 2026, minutes not yet available.
 - Cllr Bayes attended in January and reported there is to be a protest at the Senedd on 11th February and a judicial review has been set up considering a possible abuse of power by Green Gen. He understands that Bute Energy have now taken over Green Gen.
- 265) Correspondence - Carmarthenshire County Council – New restrictions on waiting and change present restrictions – significantly Pensarn – discussed previously. **NOTED**
- 266) Correspondence – Carmarthenshire County Council – Experimental Prohibition of vehicles stopping outside schools, including Llangunnor Primary School
 - Markings already in existence, assume these will now be enforced. **NOTED**
- 267) Correspondence – Member of public – objection and response to expansion of College campus at Pibwrlwyd (PL/10198)
 - Letter dated 13/01/2026 from Welsh Government as highway authority for the A48 trunk road directs that planning permission is not granted at this time as the applicant has provided insufficient information to determine the application. **ACTION** Clerk will write to the residents from whom we have received correspondence stating that we will keep all correspondence and take it into account when considering any future application. At that time we will encourage these residents to come and discuss their objections in person with the Community Council.
